**Middle Grades Knowledge Bowl** is a season of academic competitions (after-school meets that take place at middle schools around the Twin Cities), where students answer questions about history, literature, mathematics, science, current events, and everything in-between. Knowledge Bowl students apply creative thinking, improve recall, develop their interpersonal skills, and learn to communicate and collaborate effectively.

## Meet Information

During a meet, teams of six students begin with the written round, where they work cooperatively to complete a multiple-choice test. Based on their team's written round score, they're placed into rooms where three teams of five students compete to answer questions read by a coach or volunteer.

Teams compete in three to five meets throughout the season. The three regular season meets are held December through February, with an optional Kick-Off meet (November), and an optional State Invitational (February).
